

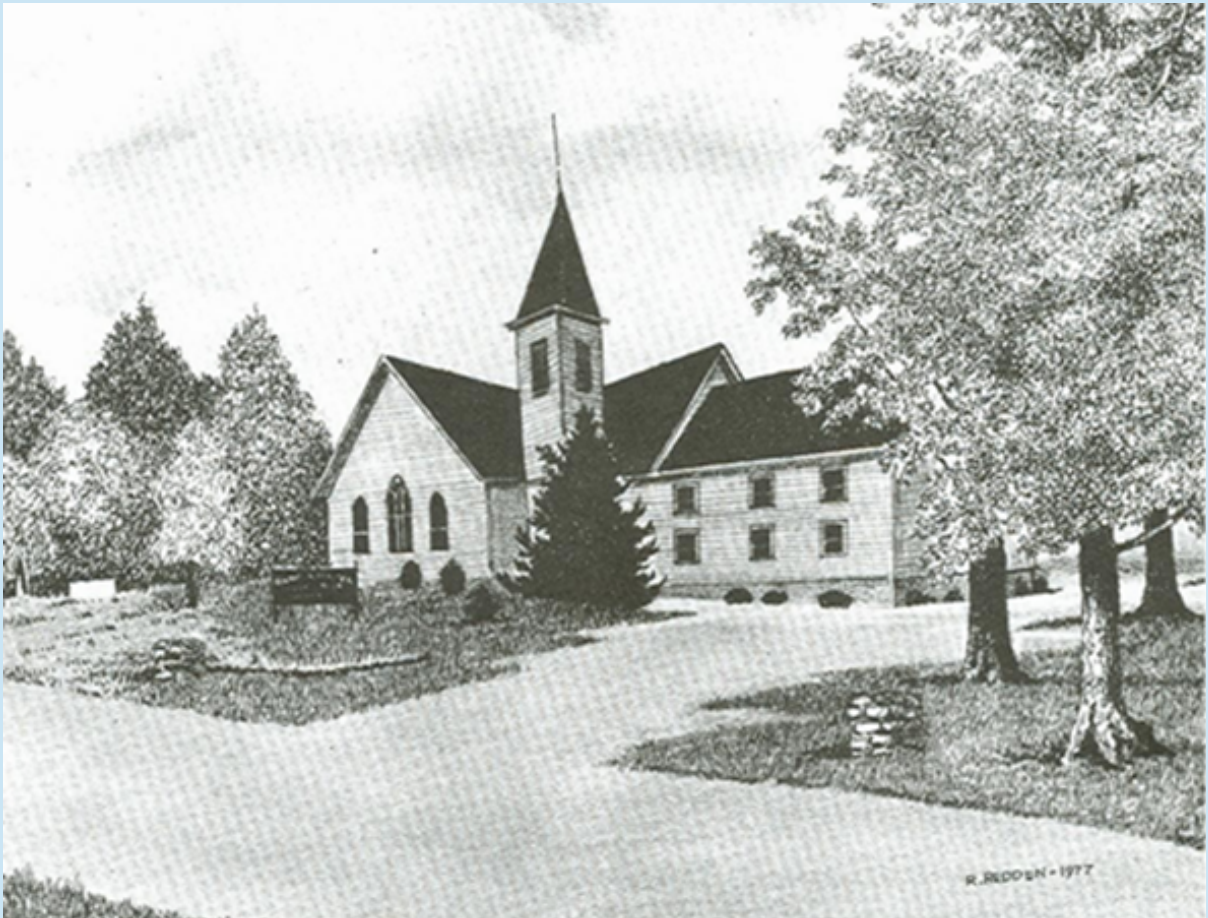

Rev. Tim's first day in the pulpit will be **July 9th at 11 a.m. worship.**

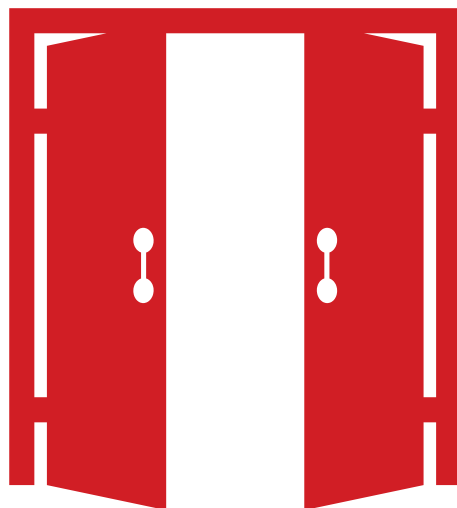


Immediately following worship, there will be a
